Digital transformation started at Vikram Solar in 2010 when SAP was introduced to integrate all major business processes. All capex & opex monthly budgets are entered in SAP Fund Management module to prevent overrun of expenses. All EPC projects are managed through SAP Project system wherein the cost budgets and Sales budgets are monitored on a daily basis. An initiative has been taken to digitally calculate the standard costs in SAP depending on alternative source of raw material, different geographical sales locations etc. The knowledge of costing will assist the Sales team to ascertain the variable pricing model. We are also implementing the SAP COPA module to determine the customer-wise, location-wise, project-wise, segment-wise profitability.

To aid decision making, Vikram Solar is implementing SAP BI-BO across all business processes. Our focus is to go green and move towards paperless organisation. SAP Fiori Apps are created so that the approvals can be given through the mobile devices. A fully automated digitised solution for inventory along with the QR Code integration will be implemented soon. To take the SAP to next level, we plan to migrate to SOH (Suit on HANA) by next January.
